FICHER means [a lot of things](#) in French. It is familiar and very common. You hear it all the time in everyday French. In this worksheet, we've chosen its most common meaning: to the heck do.

je	fiche	I the heck do
tu	fiches	you the heck do
elle	fiche	she the heck do
il/ça	fiche	he/it the heck do
on	fiche	we the heck do
nous	fichons	we the heck do
vous	fichez	you the heck do
ils	fichent	they the heck do
elles	fichent	they the heck do

## in context

What are you the heck doing?

→ Qu'est-ce que tu fiches/vous fichez ?

We don't the heck do anything here.

→ Nous ne fichons rien ici.

→ On [ne] fiche rien ici.
