to fry, to deep-fry

present tense

FRIRE is a very funny verb. It is used only in the singular¹ forms in the present tense.

pronoun	conjugation	English
je	fris	I fry/am frying
tu	fris	you fry/are frying
elle/il/on/ça	frit	she/he/we/it fries/is frying

In context

Je fris toujours les frites² sur le balcon.

→ I always fry the French fries on the balcony.

² frites is a past participle (fried) and a noun (French fries as in "the fried ones")
