nous	haïssons	we hate

elles	haïssent	they hate

in context

I hate dark chocolate.

→ Je hais le chocolat noir.

We don't hate it.

→ Nous ne le haïssons pas.

→ On ne le hait pas. [more colloquial]

Rappel: **je** = I; **tu** = you [singular and informal]; **elle** = she; **il** = he or it, **ça** = it [spoken French],
on = we [spoken everyday French], **nous** = we [more formal than "on"]; **vous** = you [plural and/or formal]; **ils** = they [masculine]; **elles** = they [feminine]
