

# SPELLING CHANGES – PRÉSENT

French verbs ending with -ger change their spelling in the *nous* form, such as our example here. The **G** takes an **E** before the ONS.

manger – to eat

pronoun	conjugation	English
je	mange	I eat
tu	manges	you eat
elle	mange	she eats
il	mange	he/it eats
on	mange	we eat
nous	mange <b>o</b> ns	we eat
vous	mangez	you eat
ils	mangent	they eat
elles	mangent	they eat

Examples:

I'm eating apples.

→ Je mange des pommes.

We eat at the .

→ Nous mangeons à une heure.

→ On mange à une heure.

je = I

tu = you singular and/or informal

elle = she

il = he

on = we spoken

nous = we more formal

vous = you plural and/or formal

ils = they masculine

elles = they feminine
