

POUSSER – PRÉSENT

This worksheet is about verbs that end in -er in their infinitive form. In order to conjugate it, first, separate the root from the ending. The ending is *er*, so what's left – *pouss* – is the root. Then add the endings for the present tense.

pousser – to push

pronoun	root	ending	English
je	pouss	e	I push
tu	pouss	es	you push
elle	pouss	e	she pushes
il	pouss	e	he/it pushes
on	pouss	e	we push
nous	pouss	ons	we push
vous	pouss	ez	you push
ils	pouss	ent	they push
elles	pouss	ent	they push

Examples:

I'm pushing the door.

→ Je pousse la porte.

We push our children to study.

→ Nous poussons nos enfants à faire des études.

→ On pousse nos enfants à faire des études. [more colloquial]

Remember?

je = I

tu = you *singular and/or informal*

elle = she

il = he, it

on = we *spoken*

nous = we *more formal*

vous = you *plural and/or formal*

ils = they *masculine*

elles = they *feminine*
