

RÉVEILLONNER

TO CELEBRATE, TO PARTY
on Christmas & New Year's eve

PRESENT

First, separate the root from the ending*. The ending is *er*, so what's left – *réveillonn* – is the root.

pronoun	root	ending	English
je	réveillonn	e	I celebrate
tu	réveillonn	es	you celebrate
elle	réveillonn	e	she celebrates
il	réveillonn	e	he/it celebrates
on	réveillonn	e	we celebrate
nous	réveillonn	ons	we celebrate
vous	réveillonn	ez	you celebrate
ils	réveillonn	ent	they celebrate
elles	réveillonn	ent	they celebrate

in context

I celebrate/party on Christmas at my parents'.

→ Je réveillonne pour Noël chez mes parents.

We celebrate/party for the New Year's in Paris.

→ Nous réveillonnons pour le nouvel an à Paris.

→ On réveillonne pour le nouvel an à Paris. [spoken French]

*Note: this rule applies to most –er verbs

je = I

tu = you *singular and/or informal*

elle = she

il = he

on = we *spoken*

nous = we *more formal*

vous = you *plural and/or formal*

ils = they *masculine*

elles = they *feminine*
