

# RÊVER – PRÉSENT

This worksheet is about a verb that ends in -er in their infinitive form. In order to conjugate it, first, separate the root from the ending. The ending is er, so what's left – rêv – is the root. Then add the endings for the present tense.

rêver – to dream

pronoun	root	ending	English
je	rêv	e	I dream
tu	rêv	es	you dream
elle	rêv	e	she dreams
il	rêv	e	he/it dreams
on	rêv	e	we dream
nous	rêv	ons	we dream
vous	rêv	ez	you dream
ils	rêv	ent	they dream
elles	rêv	ent	they dream

Examples:

I'm dreaming about living in France.

→ Je rêve de vivre en France.

We dream of a better life.

→ Nous rêvons d'une meilleure vie.

→ On rêve d'une meilleure vie. [*more colloquial French*]

Remember?

je = I

tu = you singular and/or informal

elle = she

il = he

on = we spoken

nous = we more formal

vous = you plural and/or formal

ils = they masculine

elles = they feminine
