

# VENIR – PRÉSENT

venir – to come

pronoun	conjugation	English
je	viens	I come
tu	viens	you come
elle	vient	she comes
il	vient	he/it comes
on	vient	we come
nous	venons	we come
vous	venez	you come
ils	viennent	they come
elles	viennent	they come

Examples:

I'm coming to Paris today.

→ Je viens à Paris aujourd'hui.

We come to the South of France in the summer.

→ Nous venons dans le sud de la France en été.

→ On vient dans le sud de la France en été.

Note: Many other verbs have the same conjugation as VENIR, such as:  
REVENIR (to come back), DEVENIR (to become), TENIR (to hold)

je = I

tu = you singular and/or informal

elle = she

il = he

on = we spoken

nous = we more formal

vous = you plural and/or formal

ils = they masculine

elles = they feminine
